This letter responds to the Lucas Oil Rail Lines (LNAL) submission dated January 23, 2023, to the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) seeking approval of its material modifications to the LNAL Conductor Certification Program received by FRA on January 23, 2023. LNAL has complied with FRA's procedures for submission and approval of programs as described in appendix B to 49 CFR part 242. FRA reviewed the railroad's program modification and determined that the railroad's program modification conforms with the requirements of 49 CFR part 242 for the reasons discussed below.

Your submission package states that no labor organizations are representing the railroad's employees.

The program modifications are consistent with the model of the previously approved Class III railroad programs. FRA understands that the modifications are intended to provide more detail to the conductor certification process and update contact information. Additional modifications to the submission also addressed deficiencies with the standard requirements of 49 CFR part 242, appendix B.
