

# **Overview of Grant Agreement**

Grant Agreement:	Note:
Coversheet	<ul><li>Key project information and signatures</li><li>FRA creates the coversheet at the time of obligation</li></ul>
Attachment 1: General Terms & Conditions	<ul> <li>Applies to all grants and programs</li> <li>Does <u>not</u> change project to project</li> <li>Not negotiable</li> </ul>
Attachment 2: Project- Specific Terms & Conditions	<ul><li>Applies to a single project</li><li>Modified for each project</li></ul>
Exhibits	- Do <u>not</u> change project to project



FRA develops the initial draft of Attachment 2 based on the applicant's information in the grant application.




# **Competitive Grants Application**

**Process** 

- Each Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)
   will specify application requirements as they relate to the Terms & Conditions
- Attachment 2 is developed as a part of pre-obligation
- The recipient must comply with the Terms & Conditions and government-wide requirements regarding grant performance and administration

This graphic shows the competitive grant application process. Terms & Conditions are part of the application, pre-obligation, and post-obligation process, as shown in Steps 3, 6, and 7.



#### **Article 4: Statement of Work**

- **4.3 Project Scope:** Tasks and deliverables defined by the project and lifecycle stage
- **4.4 Required environmental commitments:** identifies any commitments from NEPA/S106

#### Subtask 1.2: Project Management Plan

The Recipient will prepare a Project Management Plan (PMP), that describes how the Project will be implemented and monitored to ensure effective, efficient, and safe delivery of the Project on time and within budget. The PMP will describe, in detail, the activities and steps necessary to complete the tasks outlined in this Statement of Work.

The PMP will include a Project Schedule and Project Budget for the work to be performed under this Agreement. The Project Schedule will be consistent with the Estimated Project Schedule in Section 5.2 of this Attachment 2, but provide a greater level of detail. Similarly, the Project Budget should be consistent with the Approved Project Budget in Section 6.5 of this Attachment 2, but provide a greater level of detail.

# **Article 7: Performance Measurement Information**

- Performance measures enable FRA to assess the recipient's progress in achieving grant program goals and objectives
- Recipient will report on these performance measures in accordance with the frequency and duration specified (in Table 7-A)
- FRA develops the initial draft based on FRA's framework for measuring performance for certain projects as well as the information the applicant provided in the grant application


