Environmental Impact Statement

The preparation of the Tier 2 / project-level San Jose–Merced High-Speed Rail (HSR) Project EIR/EIS will involve development of preliminary engineering designs and assessment of environmental effects associated with the construction, operation, and maintenance of the HSR system, including track, ancillary facilities and stations, along the previously selected San Jose–Merced corridor. Previous FRA decisions were made about this section of the HSR system with the <u>Bay Area</u> to <u>Central Valley Program EIR/EIS</u>.
