

Employee Fatality: On April 4, 2025: At approximately 9:30 a.m. PST an employee was crushed in between two railcars during switching operations while shoving. This incident occurred in Richmond, California.

Take-Away

While this recent case has not yet been analyzed, the SOFA Working Group reminds all employees to remain vigilant during switching operations. Last, but not least, stop the movement in instances of uncertainty and remember to always hold a job briefing whenever the job or situation changes.
