The ideal candidate will have excellent communication skills, both written and oral, the ability to comfortably address large groups, and the ability to lead meetings associated with program reviews. The incumbent should also have experience with passenger train emergency preparedness plan and passenger equipment emergency system requirements.

Duties:

- Serve as the Passenger Train Emergency Preparedness Plan (PTEPP) Program Manager.
- Review and assess PTEPPs for compliance with 49 CFR part 239.
- Coordinate and conduct onsite field assessments regarding PTEPP implementation.
- Conduct PTEPP training and operational testing assessments.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

Qualifications: Candidates must currently be a GS-13 or GS-14 and must have experience in passenger train emergency preparedness plan and passenger equipment emergency system requirements. Candidates should also have experience planning and executing compliance audits and/or compliance investigations.
