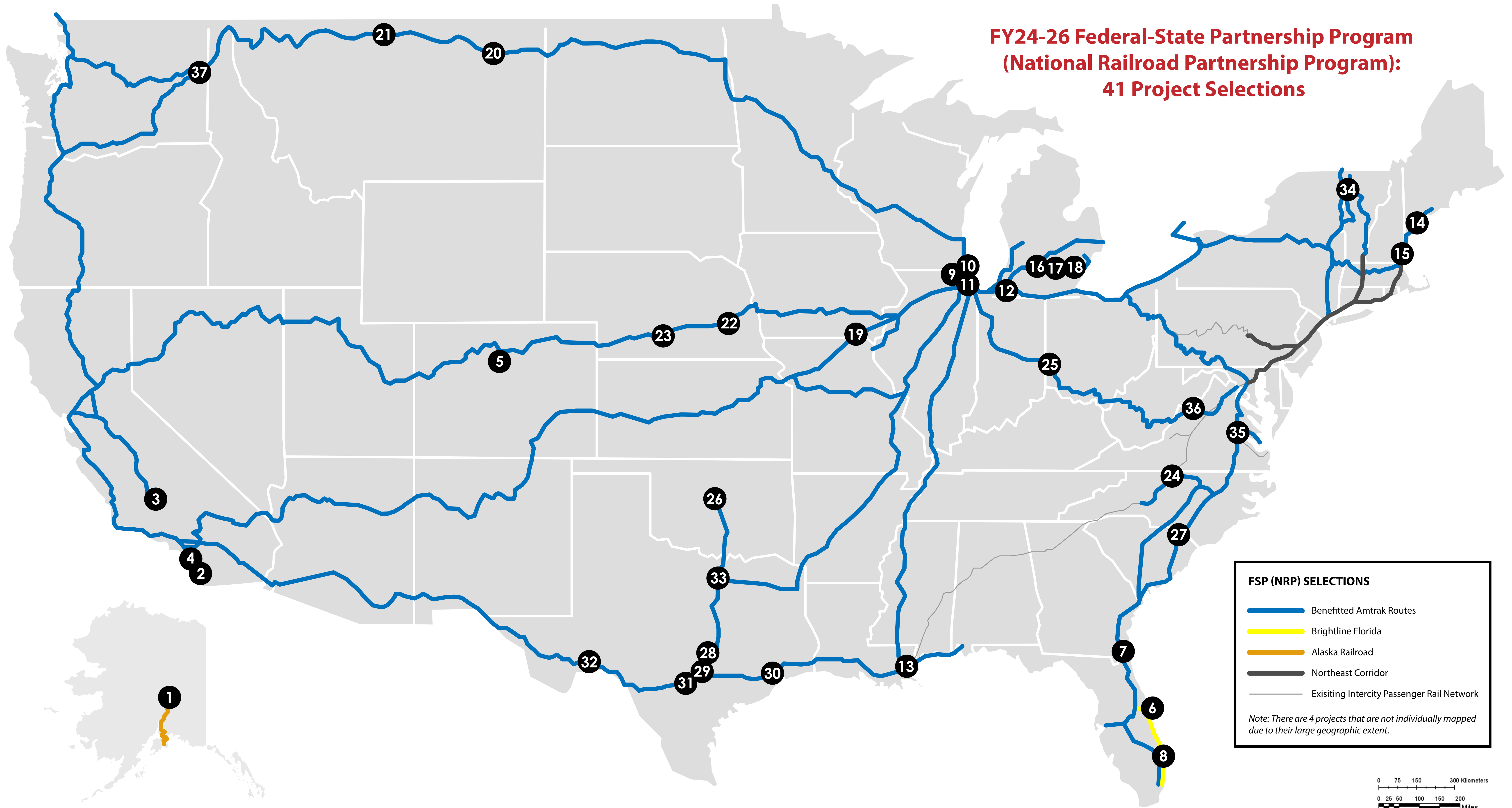

ADDITIONAL SELECTED PROJECTS

The following project was selected for award but is not individually mapped due to its large geographic extent, benefiting the Statewide intercity passenger rail network at large.

- **Florida – *Florida Department of Transportation* | *Statewide Advancement of Feature Enhancements at Intercity Passenger Rail Crossings (SAFE-IPR) Program*:** The project will benefit Brightline’s Florida route and Amtrak’s Silver Meteor, Floridian, and AutoTrain routes by performing improvements at up to 910 grade crossings.

The following projects were selected for award but are not individually mapped due to their large geographic extent, benefiting the Nationwide intercity passenger rail network at large.

- **District of Columbia/Multiple States – *National Railroad Passenger Corporation* | *Shunt Enhancement Safety*:** The project will benefit all 32 state-supported and all 15 long distance Amtrak routes.
- **District of Columbia/Multiple States – *National Railroad Passenger Corporation* | *Fleet and Facilities to Secure the Future of Amtrak State Supported Intercity Passenger Rail Service*:** The project will benefit Amtrak’s Adirondack, Blue Water, Carolinian, Cascades, D.C. to Newport News, D.C. to Norfolk, D.C. to Roanoke, Downeaster, Empire, Ethan Allen, Hartford Line, Hiawatha, Illini/Saluki, Illinois Zephyr, Keystone, Lincoln, Pennsylvanian, Pere Marquette, Piedmont, River Runner, Wolverine routes.
- **Wisconsin/Multiple States – *Wisconsin Department of Transportation* | *Overhauls for Safe Operations of the Charger Locomotive Fleet*:** The project will benefit Blue Water, Cascades, Hiawatha, Lincoln, Illini/Saluki, Illinois Zephyr, Missouri River Runner and Pere Marquette.
