

# What is Tower 55?

(hint: it's not just a cool tower)

- Proactive P3 Project
- Major railway junction in Ft. Worth, TX
- Over 100 trains daily, including 2 Amtrak
  Texas Eagle trains
- 2 N/S and 2 E/W through tracks meet at grade; the major intersection of BNSF and UP in TX
- Operating at 90% capacity
- Kind of a big deal

### **Pre-Investment Problem**

(how come a Tower costs so much?!?)

- Operating at over 90% capacity, creating rail traffic congestion and delays
- Impacts to traffic across entire north TX region
- Capacity Constrained for future rail traffic growth due to port expansion and population growth
- At grade crossings often blocked by stopped or slow moving trains

# **Project solution**

(what's the new tower look like?)

- Installation of an additional N/S Track through rail crossing
- Installation of additional tracks and siding N and S of the diamond
- Closure of 2 at-grade street crossings
- Reconstruction of 2 underpasses with addition of sidewalks and improved vehicle clearances

# P3 Keys to Success

#### **Stakeholder Motivation and Cooperation:**

- Roles and responsibilities: UP and BNSF committed over \$65 M; remained actively involved through entire project. Flow down agreement specified all stakeholder roles.
- Continuous logistical planning: timely and efficient construction needed to minimize disruption to rail traffic.

#### Partnership:

 TxDOT maintained on-site project manager and provided daily oversight, creating daily progress updates to support grant award.

# P3 Keys to Success

### Comprehensive public outreach plan:

- Identify issues up front that matter to the public
- Meet with affected constituents early and often
- Emphasize project public benefits:
  - Reduced Traffic Delays
  - Vehicle Clearance Including Emergency Vehicles
  - Improved Pedestrian Safety Including School Children
