New FRA NEPA Regulations

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Acronyms:

- ►CE: Categorical Exclusion
- ► FAST Act: Fixing America's Surface Transportation (Pub. L. No. 114-94 2015)
- MAP-21: Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (P.L. 112-141 2012)
- ► NEPA: National Environmental Policy Act
 - ► Required when there is a major Federal Action
- ► SNPRM: Supplemental Notice of Proposed Rulemaking
 - Supplements a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM)

FRA NEPA Procedures

- FRA NEPA Procedures
 - ► Published May 1999
 - ► Citation: 68 FR 28545
 - ▶ Provides procedures on <u>Section 4(f)</u>
- FRA CE List
 - ► Updated January 2014
 - ▶ Citation: 78 FR 2713
- Differs from FHWA and FTA NEPA Regulations though modes share many similar requirements
 - FHWA and FTA share NEPA Regulations
- ► Requires updates from FAST Act

About Section 4(f)...

- ▶ DOT Act of 1966 special provision in Section 4(f)
- Cannot approve the use of land for transportation projects from
 - ► Publicly owned parks
 - Recreational areas
 - ► Wildlife and Waterfowl refuges
 - ► Public or private historical sites

UNLESS:

- No feasible and prudent alternative and planning to reduce harm as occurred
- ►The use is "de minimis"

SNPRM

- Original NPRM was for FHWA and FTA issued Nov 2015 for MAP-21
- ► FAST Act required additional updates for FHWA and FTA
- Modes agreed to add FRA to FHWA and FTA NEPA and 4(f) regulations
- SNPRM proposes updates to 49 CFR Parts 771 (NEPA) and 774 (4(f) Regulations)
- ► FRA FAST Act Requirements for CEs included
- ▶ Comment period closed 11/28/17

What's Changing?

- Adds FRA to FHWA and FTA NEPA and 4(f) regulations
 - ► NEPA Regulations: 23 CFR Section 771
 - More general than current FRA NPEA Procedures
 - FHWA, FTA and FRA will share the same NEPA and 4(f) Regulations, with minor differences
- ▶4(f) Regulations: 23 CFR Section 774
- Updates regulations to account for prior statutory requirements (mainly FHWA/FTA)
- Adds and modifies FRA's list of CEs
 - Changes based on prior FR notice and comments

- CE definition and list of unusual circumstances
- Adds CE for Administrative procurements, etc.
- Adds "training" to CE for procurements
- Planning and design that does not commit FRA to a specific course of action affecting environment
- Adds CE for Geotech, small ground disturbance testing, archaeological investigations, etc.
- CE for internal policies not published in the FR

- Clarifies CE for refinancing loans
- Clarifies 'maintenance or repair of existing railroad equipment...' CE and scope of repair activities
- New Disaster Response CE that replaces existing one
- Refocuses CE for 'operating assistance for continued existing service or an increase in service...' to focus on traffic density
- CE addressing acquisitions would include "real property" and transfers

- CE for 'research, development and demonstration activities...' expanded beyond just PTC
- Adds the "...waiver of modification of existing regulatory requirements and discretionary approvals..." to CE on rulemakings, removes limitation to safety rules
- Adds "removal" to the 'bridge repair and replacement...' CE

- Focuses 'vehicle or equipment acquisition, rehabilitation, transfer or maintenance..' CE on altering traffic rather than just use of the ROW
- CE for 'environmental restoration..."
 would be expanded by removing
 limitation for just rail track/infrastructure

Proposed 4(f) Exceptions

- "Use" of a historic transportation facility dedicated to a transportation purpose
- Concrete and steel bridges after 1945 (Highway System)
- Improvements to historic railroad and transit lines
- Adds to 'restoration, rehabilitation or maintenance...' exception

 - Develop responses, including changes to proposed regs text
- ► Draft Final Rule
- ► Publish Final Rule
- No timeline (pending evaluation of comments)
 - ▶2018 publication likely, though
