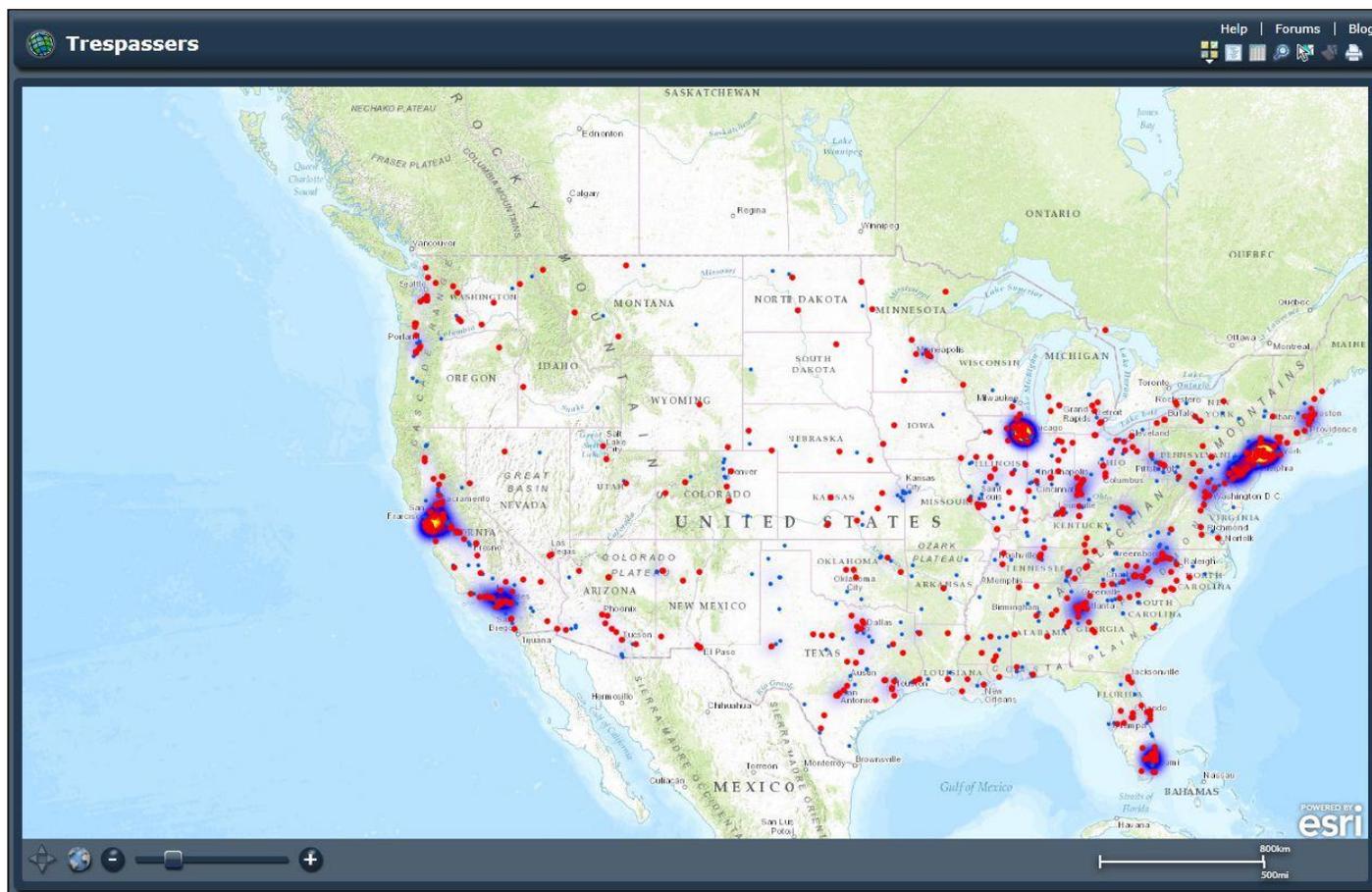

## Trespasser Application

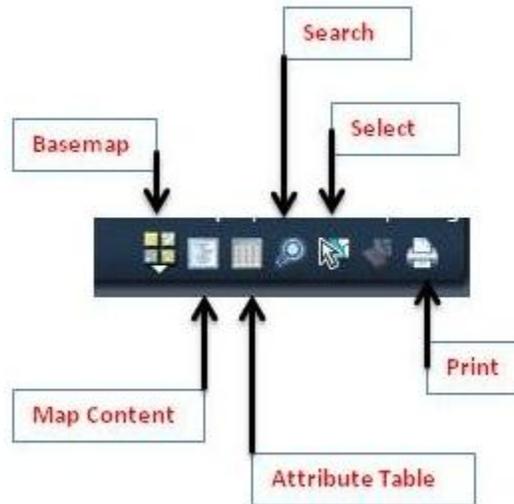

## I. Tools

Located in the top right corner



**Basemap:** Select a basemap for the map

**Map Content:** Toggle map content

**Attribute Table:** Show or hide the attribute table

**Search:** Search for places or layers

**Select:** Select features by drawing a box on the map

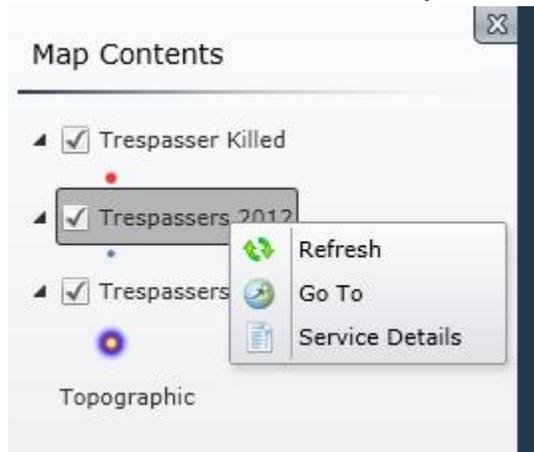
**Print:** Print the map

## II. Zooming

a. Use the tool in the bottom left corner to drag the map in or out

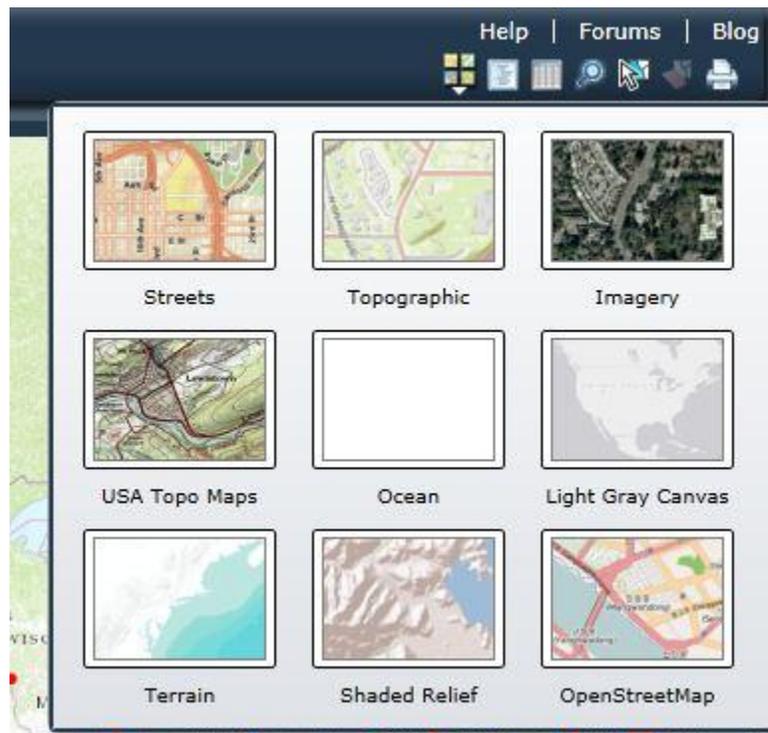


- b. Use your mouse to zoom or out  
Scroll up to zoom in  
Scroll down to zoom out
- c. Use map content “Go To” to zoom to the feature layer



### III. Background

Select your preferred background layer



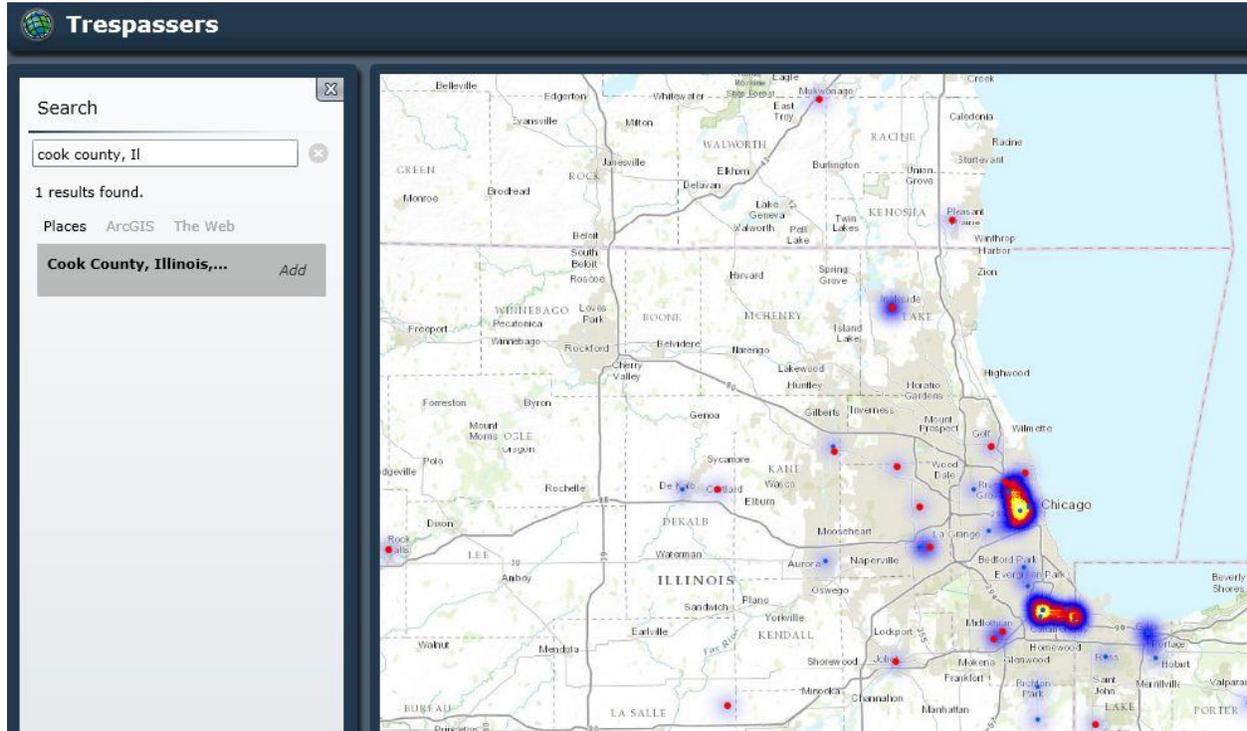
**IV. Map Content**

- Shows the layers available
- Turn layer on or off
- Zoom to specific layers



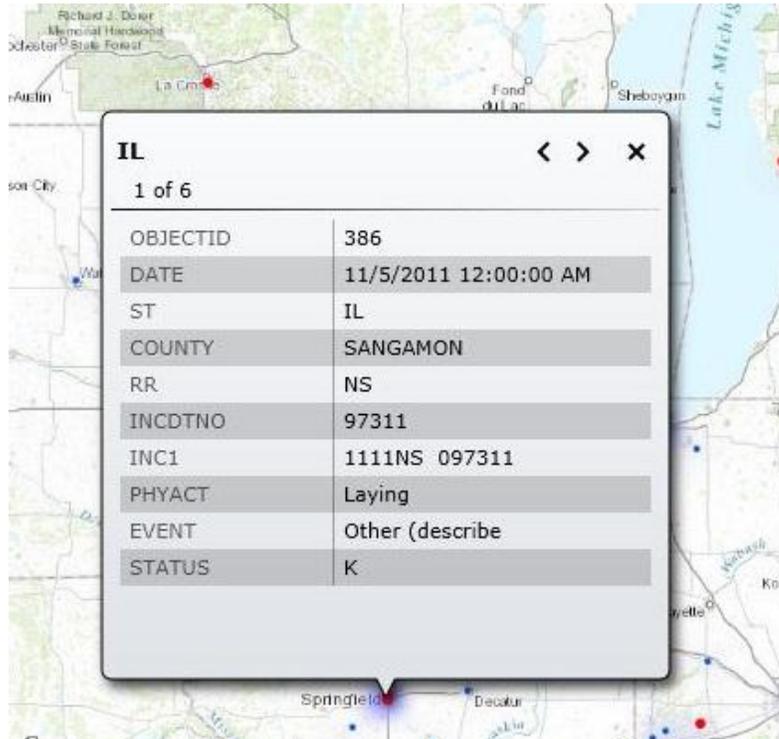
## V. Search

Enter in a location to zoom into a specific area on the map



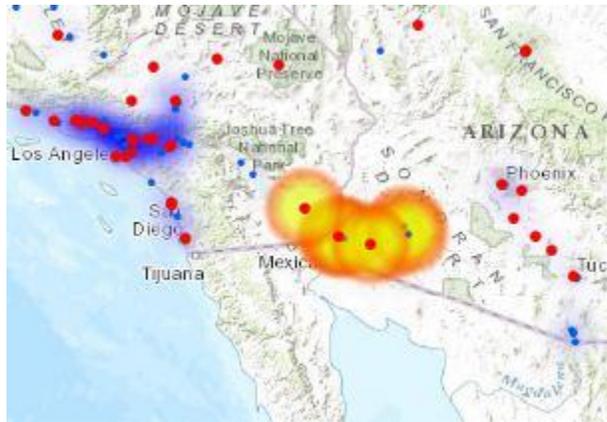
## VI. Identify

Click on an individual feature on the map to get the attribute information

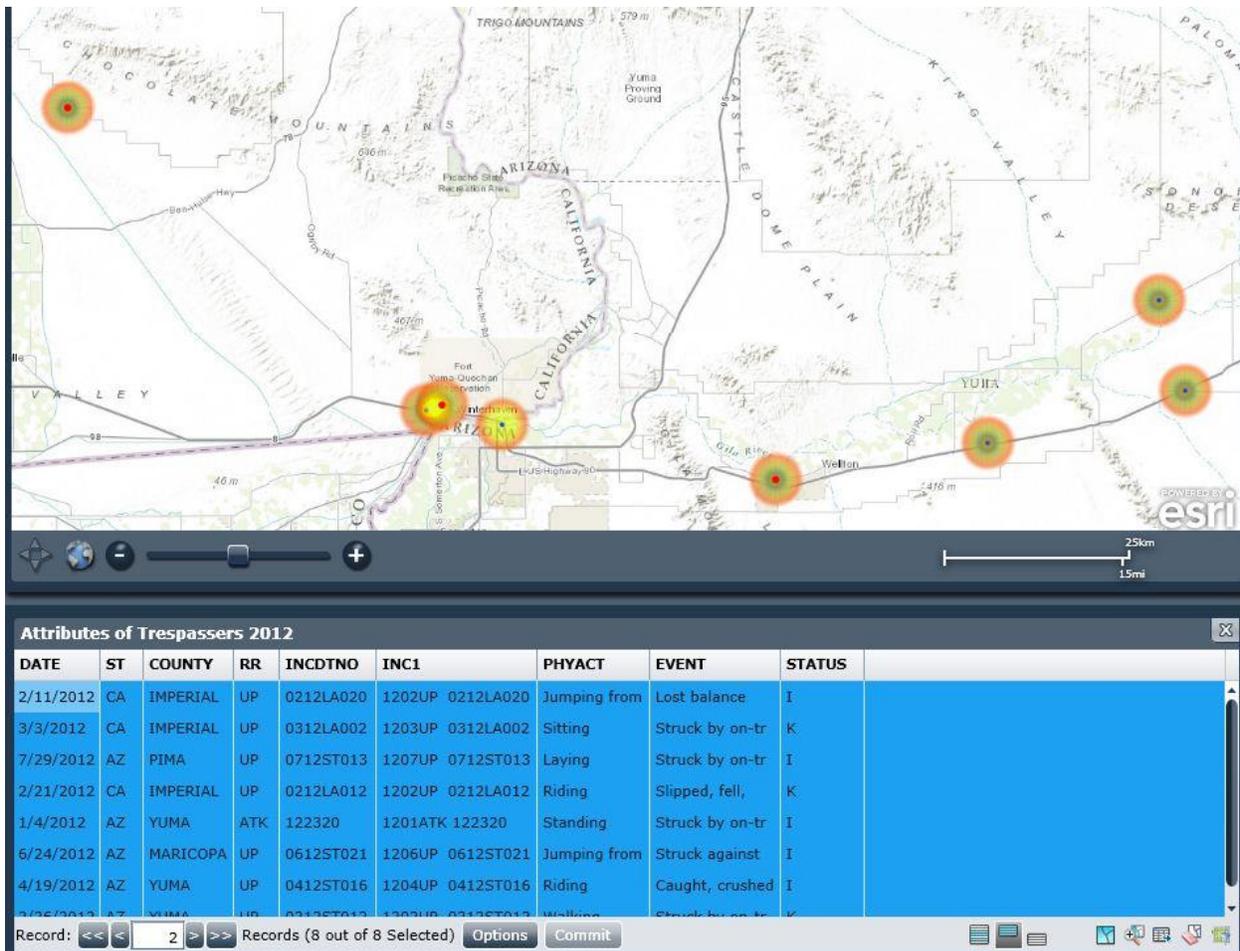


## VII. Selection & Attributes

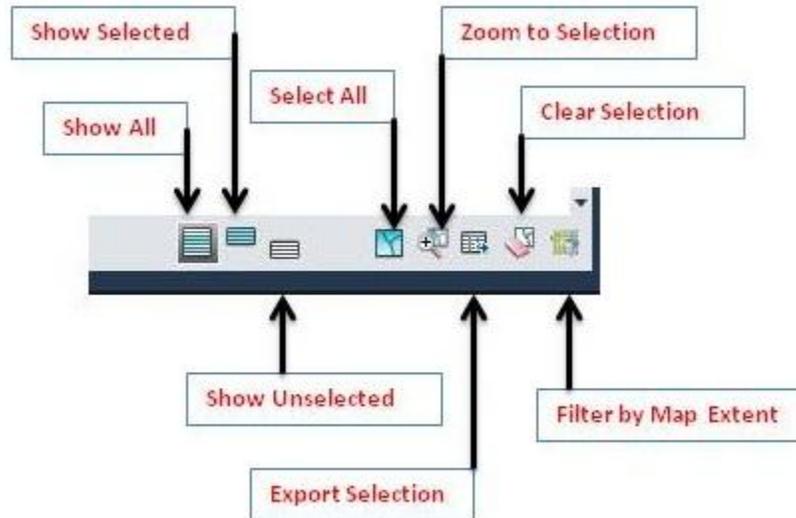
Use the Select Tool to draw a box on the map on specific features



Select Attribute Table: Show the attribute table



## ***Attribute Tools***



***Show All:*** Show records for all features in the current layer

***Show Selected:*** Show records for selected features in the current layer

***Show Unselected:*** Show records for unselected features in the current layer

***Select All:*** Select all the features in the currently selected layer

***Zoom to Selection:*** Zoom to currently selected features

***Export Selection:*** Export the attributes of selected features to a CSV file

***Clear Selection:*** Clear the selected features from the currently selected layer

***Filter by Map Extent:*** Only show records for the features within the current map extent
